

Year 1 - Public health from all angles

From September to May, students follow an intensive, multidisciplinary curriculum combining in-class learning, group work, and independent study. A recommended internship from May to July offers hands-on experience in public health practice.

Learning by doing

Students engage in hands-on learning through group case studies. These projects simulate real-world public health challenges and help develop key skills in research.

Cross-disciplinary Modules

Explore broader themes such as Global Health and Maternal & Child Health through integrated, multidisciplinary sessions.

Year 2 - Go further in Public Health

In Year 2, students follow advanced modules designed to strengthen their expertise in key public health domains. Each day of the week is dedicated to a specific discipline, allowing for immersive learning and specialization.

Core domains include:


- Prevention & Health Promotion (PHP)

- Health Policy & Management (HPM)
- Environmental & Occupational Health Sciences (EOHS)

Specialised Modules and Tracks

Students choose from a wide range of specialised modules tailored to their interests and career goals. Teaching formats vary from interactive tutorials to expert-led conferences, encouraging both depth and flexibility.

Practicum: Bridging Theory and Practice

From February to August, students complete a 4 to 6-month practicum in France or abroad, within public health agencies, NGOs, research labs, or international organizations.

Rennes is also a very wellconnected city, located just 80 minutes by train from Paris, and it has an airport serving numerous European destinations.





Motivation letter

Max. 600 words. Explain your interest in public health, your career goals, and how the MPH aligns with them. Go beyond your CV: highlight relevant experiences and your specific public health interests.

Curriculum Vitae

Diploma & Transcripts

Certified copies of all higher education degrees + official transcripts. Include English or French translations if needed.

Proof of English Proficiency

Valid test scores (IELTS, TOEFL, PTE, Cambridge) - no older than Sept. 1, 2024.

Exemptions apply only to specific countries - see the list on the MPH Website.

Two Recommendation Letters

Should be from an academic or professional contact. No reference from personal contacts.


