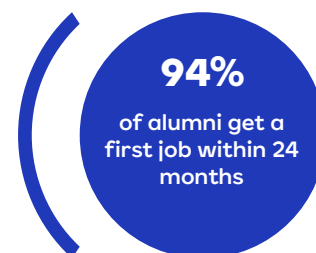
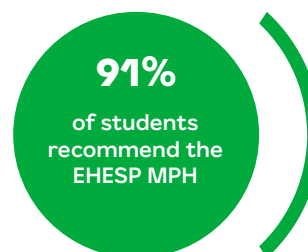

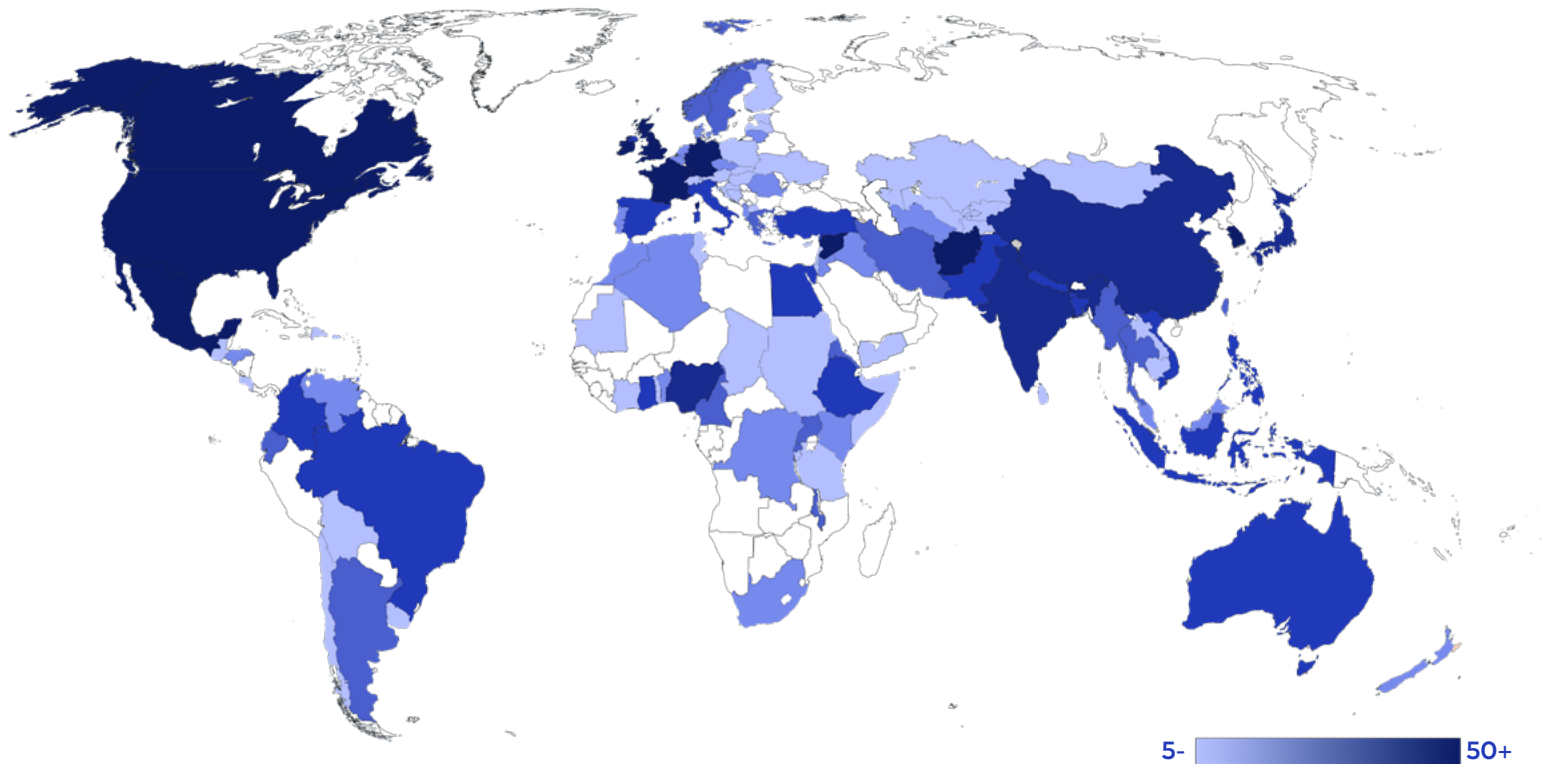

Each year, 1,200 civil servant trainees and students, and 6,000 continuing education participants.

A unique institution in France, the EHESP is both a public service grande école and a higher education and research establishment. It trains senior executives for the hospital public service and State public service managers in the health and social sectors, offers Master's and doctoral programs, as well as a broad range of continuing education courses for an audience in France and internationally.

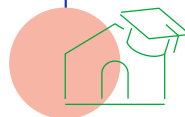

Specialised Modules and Tracks

Bridging Theory and Practice

From February to August, students complete a 4 to 6-month practicum in France or abroad, within public health agencies, NGOs, research labs, or international organizations.

Prepare your application !

- Curriculum Vitae

- Motivation letter

Max. 600 words. Explain your interest in public health, your career goals, and how the MPH aligns with them. Go beyond your CV : highlight relevant experiences and your specific public health interests.

- Diploma & Transcripts

Certified copies of all higher education degrees + official transcripts. Include English or French translations if needed.

- Proof of English Proficiency (IELTS, TOEFL, PTE, Cambridge)

Valid test scores - no older than Sept. 1, 2024.

Exemptions apply only to specific countries - see the list on the MPH Website.

- Two Recommendation Letters

Should be from an academic or professional contact. No reference from personal contacts.
